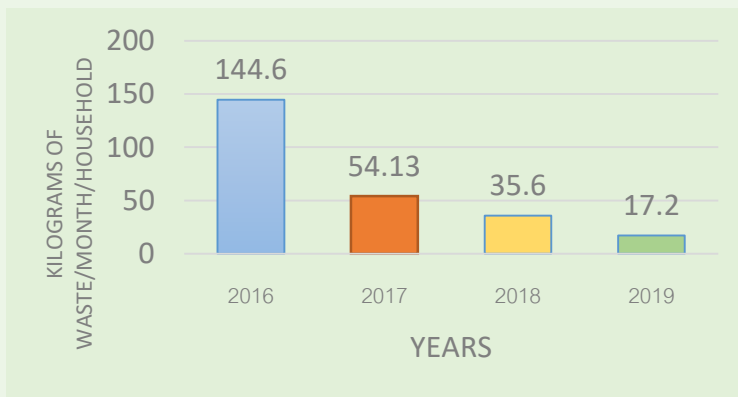


Turning One Person's Trash into Another's Treasure

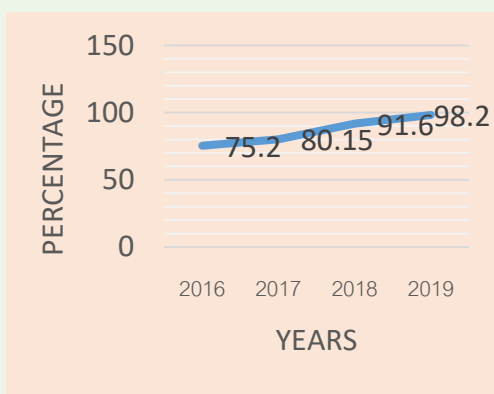
The main findings

1.The amount of waste



In 2016, before the initiation of the project, Talukmoo Village generated approximately 144.6 kilograms of waste/month/household on average. After the initiation of the project in 2019, now these households merely generated 17.2 kilograms of waste/month/household

2.The percentage of people's satisfaction



The people were highly satisfied with the project's operation, at 98 percentage

3.The other findings

- The community's members earned the additional income from the waste management and utilization at, on the average, 300-500 Baht/household/month.
- The project created the collaboration between 7 networks, namely, the networks of the housewives, the elderly people club, the village health volunteers (VHVs), the communal professional group, monks, the Community Development Department's officials, and the youth.
- 100 percent of the community's members actively participated in the project.
